



DR. ALVIN ROSENFELD is the Director of the Institute for the Study of Contemporary Antisemitism and the founder of the well-regarded Borns Jewish Studies program at Indiana University. We congratulate Dr. Rosenfeld on being named in 2023 to the Algemeiner List of 100 people positively impacting Jewish life and Israel, and is listed as number 2 out of the 100.

Dr. Rosenfeld has been honored with the Indiana University Distinguished Service Award, as well as the President's medal "in recognition of sustained Academic Excellence, Vision and Leadership resulting in lasting and widespread impact."

Professor Rosenfeld is the author of numerous books and articles dealing with the Holocaust. His most recent work is "Contending with Antisemitism in a Rapidly Changing Political Climate." Professor Rosenfeld serves as a board member and scholarly consultant to the Anti-Defamation League and the American Jewish Committee.

In May 2007, Professor Rosenfeld was awarded the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, Honoris Causa, by Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion. He has lectured on the Holocaust and Antisemitism in North America, Europe, Asia and Israel.

Dr. Alvin Rosenfeld has served as a guest lecturer for Har-El in person and on Zoom. We welcome him again and are honored to have the opportunity to be updated on the current situation of antisemitism in the United States and worldwide. His presentation and the discussion that will follow should not be missed.
